At our December 1st meeting, I also bestowed the Honorary Life Membership status on two longterm volunteers: Past Commander Danny Rodriguez and 2nd Vice Commander Terry Stickles. Congrats to these two Legionnaires for their outstanding contributions to Post activities and Legion programs!












American Legion Riders by Jim Wineland
